- When: Keep a note of the times the incidents have taken place, you can download an ASB diary from the website below.
- Who: Descriptions of the people or vehicles involved.

Contact **St.Helens Council**, or your Registered Social Landlord, to report **environmental ASB**, such as; rowdy & inconsiderate neighbours, general vandalism & graffiti, littering, abandoned vehicles, uncontrolled dogs & dog fouling on: **01744 676789** Contact **Merseyside Police** to report criminal ASB, such as threatening or offensive behaviour, drug dealing & street drinking, off-road vehicles & fireworks being set off late at night on: **101**
